#### 6. Institution Setup for Liquidity Risk Management

The Management has formed the ALCO Committee for managing the liquidity risk of the company. Being a non-deposit taking NBFC, for sources of liquidity, Indifi Capital currently depends upon Operating cash in hand; Funds held in eligible short-term investment avenues including term deposits issued by financial institutions; Liquidation of assets positions such as loans and investments; Capital infusions; and Borrowings from banks and external markets. In addition to the above the Board has approved the avenues for deployment of temporary liquidity, as mentioned in the Investment Policy. ALCO is responsible for determining the appropriate mix of available funding sources utilized to ensure a company's liquidity is managed prudently and appropriately.

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
